

**Unit 2** (P.9-15)**Part B**

Man : Please put the grapes on the table.  
 Boy : Sorry? Where do I put the grapes?  
 Man : Put the grapes on the table. Next to the box.  
 Boy : OK. I can do that.

*Can you see the line? This is an example.  
 Now you listen and draw lines.*

Boy: Can I put the lemon in the cupboard?  
 Man: Pardon?  
 Boy: The lemon. Can I put it in the cupboard?  
 Man: Yes, please.

Man: Now, the pineapple. Put it in the woman's hand.  
 Boy: Where do I put it?  
 Man: In the woman's hand. Put the pineapple there.  
 Boy: Right. It's there now.

Man: And now the orange. Put it on the fridge.  
 Boy: On the fridge?  
 Man: Yes, put the orange on the fridge.  
 Boy: OK, I can do that.

 Can you put it under the table?

Girl: Tom, do you like badminton?  
Boy: No, I don't.  
Girl: Well, do you like football?  
Boy: It's OK. But my favourite sport is baseball.

1. *Where's the bag?*

Girl: Mum, I can't find my bag.  
Woman: Is it on the sofa?  
Girl: No, it isn't there. And it isn't on the bed.  
Woman: Look! It's next to the bookcase.  
Girl: Oh, yes, there it is.

2. *Which is John's new jacket?*

Women: You've got a new jacket, John. Which is it?  
Boy: Well...not the red one. I don't like red.  
Women: Is it the yellow one?  
Boy: No, it isn't. It's the brown one.  
Brown is my favourite colour.

3. *What can Allen do?*

Man: You like music, Allen. Can you play the guitar?  
Boy: No. I can't. My brother can play the guitar.  
Man: And can you dance, then?  
Boy: Well, I like singing. I can sing well.

4. *What's Joy doing?*

Boy: What's Joy doing? Mum?  
Women: I don't know. Is she reading?  
Boy: No, and she isn't listening to music.  
Women: Oh, I see her! She's doing her homework  
in her bedroom.

5. *Where are Mary's glasses?*

Women: I can't find your glasses.  
Where are they, Mary?  
Girl: Well, aren't they in the living room?  
Women: No, they aren't. Do you see them  
in your bedroom?  
Girl: Oh, here they are. They are in the kitchen.  
I put them on the table.

Girl: Pardon?

Girl: Oh, yes. Can I colour it?  
Man: Yes, please colour it black.  
Girl: Great. Black is my favourite colour.

Man: Find the boat in the tree.

Girl: The boat in the tree? I'd like it be yellow.  
Man: Yellow! That's great.

Man: Now, can you see the big boat in the pond?

OK, it is green now.

### Part B

Man : Put the radio on the shelf.  
Girl : Pardon? Put the radio where?  
Man : The radio on the shelf.  
Girl : Right.

Girl: This phone?  
Man: Yes. Please put it on the mat.

#### 1. What's Bill doing?

Girl: Dad, what's Bill doing? Is he playing basketball?  
Man: No. Isn't he playing his computer games?  
Girl: No, he's not. He's not in his room.  
Man: Is he watching TV?  
Girl: Oh, yes. He is in the living room.

#### 2. Which woman is Sam's teacher?

Man: Is Sam's teacher wearing a grey jacket?  
Girl: No, she's wearing a blue jacket.  
Man: Is she wearing trousers?  
Girl: No, she's wearing a purple skirt.

#### 3. Which book does Alex want?

Woman: Here's a book on basketball. Do you like it, Alex?  
Boy: No, thanks. Is there a book on bikes?  
Woman: Sorry, I can't find one. Look. This book's great.  
There are lots of dinosaurs in it.  
Boy: Great. I like dinosaurs. I want this one.

#### 4. Where is the cat?

Boy: Do you see my cat? Is it sleeping on the bed?  
Woman: No, it's not. It's not in your bedroom.  
Boy: Is it sleeping in the bathroom?  
Woman: Mmm...There it is. Under the sofa.

#### 5. What is Ann's lunch?

Man: What have you got for your lunch, Ann?  
A sandwich and some milk?  
Girl: I've got a sandwich, but I don't like milk.  
Man: Have you got any juice?  
Girl: No, I eat apples. I like apples.

## Part E

Boy: I love this picture. Look at all the flowers.  
Man: Yes. Can you colour them for me?  
Boy: OK. Can I colour the flower next to the girl pink?  
Man: The flower next to the girl, pink. Yes. Good.

*Can you see the pink flower next to the girl?  
This is an example.  
Now you listen and colour.*

Man: Now, find the flower between the dog and the box.  
Boy: Sorry? Between what?  
Man: The flower between the dog and the box.  
Colour it purple.  
Boy: Purple? OK. I'm doing it now.  
Man: Great.

Man: Can you see the flower on the dog's tail?  
Boy: Where's the flower?  
Man: On the dog's tail.  
Boy: Oh, yes. There it is.  
Man: Colour this flower brown.  
Boy: A brown flower? OK.

Man: There is one flower on the table.  
Boy: Yes, I can see it. It's next to the basket.  
Man: Can you colour it green?  
Boy: Green is my favourite colour.  
Man: Good. A green flower on the table.

4

Man: Look at the flower in the tree.  
Boy: The flower in the tree? Yes. Can I colour it?  
Man: Yes. What colour do you like?  
Boy: Can I have a blue flower?  
Man: Blue. That's fine.

Boy: What can I do now?  
Man: Well, there's a flower behind the chair.  
Boy: Oh, yes. I can see it.  
Man: Colour the flower behind the chair yellow.  
Boy: OK. The flower is yellow now.
